COMMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Violation #5 Repair ceiling nets in the second floor. Remove bird droppings from second floor hallway (Correcting during inspection).
Code Reference FAC: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

Violation #22
 -Replace damaged dumpster, must be leak proof. Clean surrounding area.
 -Provide drain plug for garbage container next to damaged dumpster.
Code Reference FAC: Solid Waste 64E-13.004(9). Garbage, trash, and rubbish shall be collected, stored, and disposed of at a frequency and in a manner that prevents a sanitary nuisance. Wet garbage shall be collected and stored in impermeable, leak proof, fly tight containers pending disposal. Outdoor waste containers must be easily cleanable, serviceable, and should be located on a smooth nonabsorbent surface. Waste containers and the storage area shall be cleaned at frequent intervals to prevent odors and breeding places for vermin. Waste water from the cleaning of garbage containers shall be disposed of as sewage.

Violation #23 Eliminate old roach droppings from lower cabinet in rooms # 1-028 and 1-031. No live roach present at time of inspection.
Code Reference FAC: Infestation/Control 64E-13.004(10). Effective measures shall be used to prevent harborage, propagation, or infestations of rodents and all insects.
